

# Two Table Join



<b>Address</b>	{value_address}
<b>Contact Person</b>	{value_contact_person}
<b>Mobile Number</b>	{value_mobile_number}
<b>Email</b>	{value_email}

Outputting data from two tables is almost as easy as displaying from one. This example utilizes two tables with state information on them. The first table (state\_order) contains state abbreviations (state), state names (statename) the year each state was admitted into the union (year) and the numeric order they entered in (entered). The second table (state\_capitals) contains state abbreviations (state), state names (state) and state capitals (capital). The where statement looks to make a match on the field that each table has in common to output the correct capital with all the info from the state\_order table.
