SSRS provides a full range of ready-to-use tools and services to help you create, deploy, and manage reports. With Reporting Services, you can create interactive, tabular, graphical, or free-form reports from relational, multidimensional, or XML-based data sources. You can publish reports, schedule report processing, or access reports on-demand. Reporting Services also enables you to create ad hoc reports based on predefined models, and to interactively explore data within the model. Tutorial presents Reporting Services introduction.
